Q: What is a CASA Ambassador?

A: CASA Ambassadors are a key link to help Henrico CASA maximize its reach and increase its awareness in the Greater Richmond community. Henrico CASA Ambassadors believe in the mission that children who experience abuse and neglect should receive a caring advocate and believe in a vision that all children should live in safe, happy, loving homes.

CASA Ambassadors help Henrico CASA carry out numerous awareness, advocacy and fundraising campaigns throughout the year to help open new doors to attract program participants, raise funds, and recruit volunteers and friends to CASA.

Q: What am I helping by supporting your efforts?

A: Henrico CASA is a local nonprofit that promotes safe, stable, and loving homes for all children. To achieve this goal the program recruits, screens, trains, and supervises competent volunteers dedicated to representing the best interests and needs of abused and neglected children before the juvenile court.

Your support will go directly to the organization's mission of recruiting and training volunteers to advocate for children who have experienced abuse and neglect.

Q: How can I help support your efforts?

A: Here are some ways you can support my work as a CASA Ambassador:

Open Doors. Think about who you may know (friends, family members, colleagues, companies) that you can introduce to CASA and help me arrange a meeting or speaking engagement to share our mission.

Host an Event. Open up your home to allow me to host a small group of individuals to learn more about CASA.

Provide Support. Make a gift. Ambassadors are required to make a minimum contribution of \$2,000 to Henrico CASA each year and gifts at any amount are appreciated – and tax deductible!
